#### Family Time

Dinner is served! Each week we share a delicious kid-friendly family-style meal. Our weekly theme is carried out in the grace, the food, the thank you to our wonderful volunteer cooks and most of all in the crazy games we play in our table groups. #### Bible Study

The Bible comes alive through investigative study and hands on learning. Each participant will get their own workbook to use throughout the year filled with stories, questions, games and reflection. #### Worship Skills

We're glad you asked! Here are the details:

LOGOS lasts 25 weeks starting Thursday, September 19, 2013.

Your registration fees include **dinner each Thursday, a student workbook, music scores, outings, and all craft and recreation equipment**. There are no hidden costs and there will be no fundraising asked of anyone.

#### Fees for the full 25 weeks are:

\$150.....for each child in your family  
\$75..... adult meals prepaid  
\$430.....family limit

Make cheques payable to **Knox LOGOS**. Payment may be divided into 2 installments: half due September 20, 2013, with a postdated cheque for November 1, 2013 for the remainder of the fees. Both cheques should be submitted with the registration form.
